Proposed Updates to Custom!

After August's meeting, the seneschal published these proposed changes to custom for discussion and voting at the September meeting. Any comments or suggestions should be submitted by email to <u>seneschal@bbm.eastkingdom.org</u> prior to the meeting.

Change# 1:

IV. The Baronage.

- 3. Champions
 - a. he Baronage may select champions (the "Baronial Champions") to represent whatever endeavors and in whatever fashion they choose in their sole discretion.
 - b. The Baronial Champions serve at the discretion of the Baronage, for a term determined by the Baronage.
 - c. Upon selection by the Baronage, the new Baronial Champions will provide a means of contact (email or telephone) to the Seneschal and Baronage.
 - e. d. The location and manner of selection of new Baronial Champions will be determined by the Baronage in consultation with the current Baronial Champions.

Change #2:

V. The Officers.

- 3. Baronial Officers will serve for the terms defined by Kingdom Law. In the event that Kingdom Law does not define a term, Baronial Officers will serve for a term of four years.
 - a. Unless otherwise specified in Kingdom Law, Baronial Officers may be reelected for consecutive 1 year terms if there are no other applicants for their position.
 - b. At least 4 months prior to the close of each Officer's maximum term limit, the Seneschal will call for applications. An incumbent officer may re-apply if they do not have a term limit defined by Kingdom Law.
 - c. All Baronial Officers shall make a good-faith effort to find an Emergency Deputy.

d. In the event that a Baronial Officer has not submitted a report to the Baronial Seneschal for a period of one year, their office will be deemed vacant, and a successor will be elected. This election shall occur within 1 month or less of the vacancy.

Change #3:

V. The Officers.

- 5. Baronial Officers will be elected by the Populace.
 - a. Applicants for a Baronial office must submit a letter of intent to the Baronage, the Seneschal, and the incumbent Baronial Officer.
 - b. Notice of applicants for a baronial office and the date of the Meeting where the vote will take place will be published to the official baronial email list, official social media page, and, when possible, in the Newsletter.
 - c. Baronial Officers will be selected by a plurality of the Populace present at the designated Meeting.
 - e. An incoming Baronial Officer will be deemed appointed as Deputy-Elect at the Meeting where the Populace vote is taken, unless the officer position they applied for is vacant.
 - f. Deputy-Elects will train with their incumbent officer for a period of time between 3 to 12 months from their election. The maximum time period of 12 months of training may not be exceeded.
 - g. All new Baronial Officers will swear fealty to the Baronage and Populace of BBM at the next Baronial Court following their installation.

Change #4:

V. The Officers.

- 6. Baronial Officers will make best efforts to attend all Meetings. If a Baronial Officer cannot attend a Meeting, they will provide the Seneschal with a report sufficiently in advance of the Meeting for the report to be read into the minutes.
- Baronial Officers will publish submit their contact information on the Website and in the Newsletter to the Seneschal and Webminister. This will include a) their legal name; b) a phone number; c) an email address, and d) their Membership ID# for any warranting from their Kingdom superior if there is one.
- 8. The Chronicler, Webminister, and Social Media Deputy are three separate offices, to be held by three separate Baronial Officers at any given point. The only acceptable combination of these three positions is as an administrative Deputy to each other for support.

Change #5:

VI. Policies.

- 3. A meeting of the Baronial Officers and Populace (the "Meeting") will be held every month except July, with the exception to July noted below.
 - i: Should there be any urgent matters requiring discussion in July, the July business meeting may be moved to earlier in the month where possible.

Change #6:

VII. Event Policies.

4. Events must be published in the Chanticleer Kingdom Newsletter (Pikestaff) and Kingdom Online Event Calendar prior to their occurrence.

Change #7:

VII. Event Policies.

- 7. The person in charge of a Major Event (the "Event Steward") or their designee must attend the two Meetings immediately prior to the Major Event.
 - a. If attendance at the Meetings is a hardship for the Event Steward or their designee, they may request that one of the Meetings be moved to a location that will allow them to attend, or they may request a videoconference meeting with sufficient notice in advance. The Barony will make a good faith effort to accommodate such a request.
 - b. In the event that there is a request to move an in-person Meeting, the person requesting the change will be responsible for providing an appropriate site has the option of either finding an appropriate site or may request to attend via videoconference. Written permission must be granted by the Seneschal in advance to confirm either arrangement.

NOTE:

All applicants must:

- Be paid members of the SCA, Inc. by the time of election for their respective office.
- Include mention in their application that a good-faith effort shall be made to maintain current membership through their term(s) in office.
- Submit a letter of intent by email to the Seneschal and Coronet prior to their application deadline, at seneschal@bbm.eastkingdom.org, baroness@bbm.eastkingdom.org, and baroness@bbm.eastkingdom.org)
- Be familiar with Baronial Custom and Kingdom Law or Kingdom Handbooks governing their office.
- Marshalate applicants are strongly encouraged to hold current marshalate warrants for their position wherever possible. Marshalate applicants without a current warrant at time of election may only act in an administrative role, and may not run practices or marshalate activities themselves.

- The Barony has no loaner equipment. Any loan of equipment is between individuals.

- There will be an attestation form to be signed by participants to confirm they have had proof of vaccine status checked by the marshal in charge.
- There is a restroom in the Archery Shop, but the owner doesn't tend to show up until after 11am, so plan accordingly.
- BYO sundries: It is a wooded area so please bring your own bug spray, sunblock, snacks, drinks, and pack out what you bring in.
