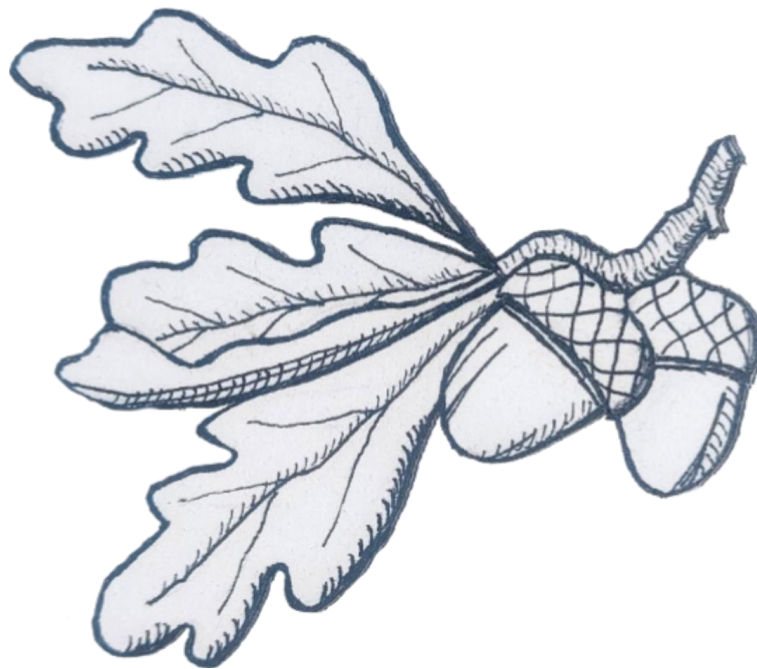

About the Tournament

Where do I sign up?

There is a square canvas tent with black trim (dags) near the archery field on site. This is the marshal's / Event Stewards tent, and will also serve as shade and shelter during the course of the day for archers.

Sign up begins at 9:30 AM Saturday, May 20th at the table under the tent.

Have Fun and Bring Your Best!

While the tournament proper was designed to be a challenge and cause archers to think about what shoots work best for them, it is also open to ALL gentles to participate in, so long as everyone shoots safely!

The archery community is very welcoming (albeit often located in distant parts of events due to real estate needs), and we love seeing our community grow. Groups of archers will be organized after morning court (10:00 AM), so don't worry if you don't have a group organized in advance.

Permitted weapons forms include:

- Recurve
- Longbow
- Medieval Crossbow

Archery is a family activity – there are no age barriers, but we do recommend that parents of small children keep their little ones close, and always pay heed to the line marshals and marshals in charge. Never cross the line while a range is active, and always be courteous by watching where you step when retrieving your arrows.

Rules, Responsibilities, and Thanks

Think you have what it takes to chase away the gods of mischief?

This shoot welcomes ALL archers of any skill level, but only two will become the East Kingdom's Champions at the end of the day.

The overall winner of this tournament will be the Consort's Champion, with the format for the Sovereign's Champion to be decided on the morning of the shoot. The Captain General of Archers will explain the rules and responsibilities of participants and winners before the Championship begins on Saturday (after 10:00 AM morning court).

Please do not litter.

Friendly well-behaved dogs are welcome! Please clean up after them.

This site is wet and smoking is allowed on the edge of the property.

No open flames or smoking is permitted within 15ft of any building.

The site speed limit is **10 mph**, Please park where designated.

Be kind and courteous to the QVEA volunteers on site.

Camps: Above ground fire pits only, no ground fires on site.

Use of out of state firewood is forbidden per CT State Law.

This is a drug-free site. Use of drugs that produce a high is forbidden.

Driving to your camp to load/unload is allowed, but do not block roads.

Please stay south of the pond if on foot (sorry, no swimming!).

Kindly do not sit on or climb on any farm equipment on site. Thank you!
